Warwickshire County Council **has made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

Effect of Order	Public Footpath from Cox's Lane to St. Lawrence Church, Napton-on-the-Hill is closed to all traffic.
Reason for Order	To safely enable works to divert and abandon old water network infrastructure.
Order Effective from: 2 January 2024 for up to 6 months or until works are completed, whichever is the sooner.	
Anticipated Completion Date: 22 January 2024	
Access & Diversion: An alternative route will be signed and is available via: School Hill, Vicarage Road, Church Hill and vice versa. Access & egress will be maintained where possible.
