

NEW EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR BOX

Napton Parish Council have purchased and installed a new external defibrillator box at the Cross Roads Garage location allowing the northside of the village and A425 road users to have 24/7 access to a potential lifesaving medical device.

The box was paid for using a £500 grant obtained from Warwickshire County Council's - Councillor Grant Funding from Councillor Andy Crump.

Napton Parish Council would also like to thank Cross Roads Garage for their support in allowing the box to be installed on their building, helping in sourcing an electrician to complete the installation, and kindly agreeing to pay for the electricity used by the box.

LOCATED AT CROSS ROADS GARAGE

In an emergency, please call 999 and ask for an ambulance. The call handler will guide you through how to perform CPR and will also tell you where the nearest defibrillator is located and how to access it.

DEFIBRILLATOR LOCATIONS

The Parish Council is the guardian of 4 defibrillators in the area, located at the following publicly-accessible points:

- **Bus Shelter** - High Street, Napton CV47 8LZ (24hr access)
- **Napton Village Stores** - New Street, Napton CV47 8LR (Store hours only)
- **Cross Roads Garage** - Shuckburgh Road, Napton CV47 8NJ (24hr access)
- **Napton Sports Field** - Napton CV47 8PH (24hr access)
