## SOUTH WARWICKSHIRE LOCAL PLAN - PREFERRED OPTIONS CONSULTATION

# Have your say on the future of South Warwickshire



<b>Who?</b>	Stratford-on-Avon and Warwick District Councils are working jointly to create a new Local Plan for South Warwickshire.
<b>What?</b>	The Preferred Options consultation sets out the preferred approach to the planning policies that the councils will use to assess applications for development, and sets out potential growth areas to meet the development needs of the two districts.  Not all of the potential growth areas will be required in the plan period – we are consulting on these now to help inform our choices.
<b>Where?</b>	Online at <a href="http://www.southwarwickshire.org.uk/swlp/preferred-options">www.southwarwickshire.org.uk/swlp/preferred-options</a> or in libraries and both Council offices.
<b>When?</b>	From <b>Friday 10 January</b> to <b>Friday 7 March 2025</b> .
<b>Why?</b>	We want your comments on the policy directions / policies and potential growth areas that are set out in the Local Plan.  The New Local Plan will affect the way we live, work, visit and play in the area, so its important to have your say!

### Topics in the Local Plan that you will be able to comment on include

- Growth Strategy
- Green Belt
- Infrastructure
- Climate Change
- Employment
- Environment
- Housing

### To respond to the consultation we suggest using our Online Consultation Portal

You can respond to each part of the consultation document using the following four questions:

- Do you agree with the approach laid out in the draft policy/policy direction?**
- Do you broadly support the proposals in this chapter?**
- Do you agree with this proposed Strategic Growth Location/ proposed New Settlement location being considered for inclusion within the plan?**
- Do you have any comments on a specific site proposal or the Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment (HELAA) results?**

Each question can be answered with either 'Yes / No / Other' and there is the opportunity to add further comments.
