Subject: Item 13 - Funding Approval for New Street Signs and Installation - Unnamed Road

Purpose:

To present the need for a new street sign on the Unnamed Road and seek council approval to allocate funding for its purchase and installation.

Background:

A visible and legible street name sign will be required for the unnamed road (proposed as *Danil's Way*) if and when the road naming application is approved by SDC.

The Parish Council has powers under the Public Health Act 1925, Section 19, to erect and maintain street nameplates and is responsible for ensuring clear signage in its jurisdiction.

Benefits:

- Improved Public Safety: Emergency services can locate properties more quickly.
- **Better Navigation:** Assists delivery drivers and visitors in finding the correct address.
- **Civic Appearance:** Enhances the overall look and order of the village environment.

Financial Implications:

- Estimated cost for supply of the sign (excluding VAT): £300.00 per sign
- Estimated cost for installation by SDC (excluding VAT): £140.00 per sign
- Total estimated cost for 2 signs (excluding VAT): £880.00
- If approved, the purchase can be partially funded through the Council's existing
 Village Maintenance budget (£2,500.00) and/or supplemented by the Village
 Improvements Reserves fund (£10,000.00).

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Parish Council:

- Approves the purchase and installation of new street signs, if approval to proceed with the road naming application is agreed.
- Allocates funding from the Village Maintenance budget.
